# Getting to the venue by car or taxi

**We have over 1200 car parking spaces on-site including 25 Blue Badge holder spaces. On larger events, we may have free buggies and buses running a service from our car parks to the main entrance.**

**The East Court car park is open during the day & for events at Alexandra Palace. Our postcode is N22 7AY and we will have signage and traffic marshals on site to assist.**



**There is step free access onto and through the length (500 meters) of the Terrace. From here, you can access the entrance to our Ice Rink & Palm Court. Both of these entrances are step free.**



**On concerts, our taxi drop off/pickups is located in the East Car Park. Please speak to our traffic team on arrival who will point you in the right direction.**

**There is also Blue Badge parking located in the Grove car park. If you are parking at the Grove, there is a 200 metre required up a hill to reach the Palm Court.**



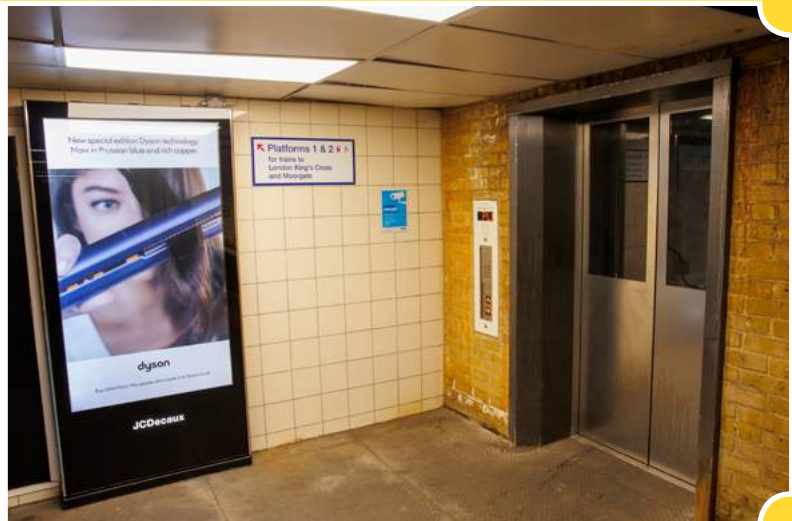
# Getting to the venue by train

The closest accessible station to Alexandra Palace is Finsbury Park. The tube station is located on the Piccadilly line.

The closest accessible train station is Finsbury Park overground & underground station.



There is an accessible lift via all platforms on the underground & overground at Finsbury Park.



When you leave Finsbury Park station, exit left on to Station Place then turn left on to Stroud Green Road. This will take you to the Finsbury Park bus station for the W3 bus. This route is approximately 400 metres and is step free.





# Getting to the venue by Bus

Alexandra Palace is accessible via the W3 bus that stops right outside the venue crosses with other major bus routes in Wood Green and Finsbury Park.

The Alexandra Park bus stop is the closest bus stop to Pitch & Putt & East Court entrance of Alexandra Palace. Both are accessible via step-free routes.



The closest bus stop to the Ice Rink is the Alexandra Palace Ice Rink. The entrance to the Ice Rink is accessible via one set of stairs on the west side of the Palace leading up to the South Terrace. There are 23 steps on each set of stairs.



The Alexandra Palace Palm Court stop is the closest to the Palm Court entrance which is used for shows in The Great Hall. The Palm Court entrance is accessible via 23 steps which lead up to the South Terrace or be walking up 100 metres up the hill to the left hand side of the bus stop.
