

## Getting to Alexandra Palace by public transport



Alexandra Palace Station

### By train

The train station at Alexandra Palace is called **Alexandra Palace Station**. It is at the Wood Green entrance to the Park. The train station at Alexandra Palace is not step free.



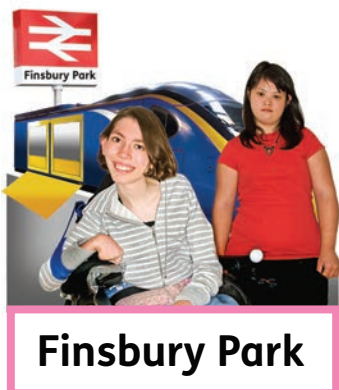
You can get the train from:

- **Moorgate.** You will not need to change trains

or

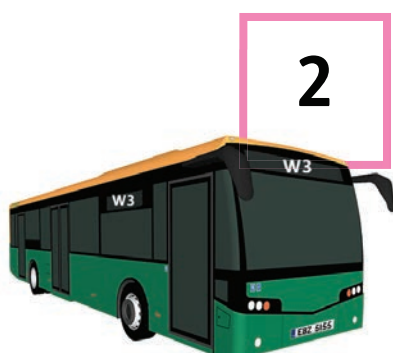


- **King's Cross.** You will need to change at Finsbury Park



## If you use a wheelchair

You can get on the tube or train to **Finsbury Park** station. There are no steps at this station.



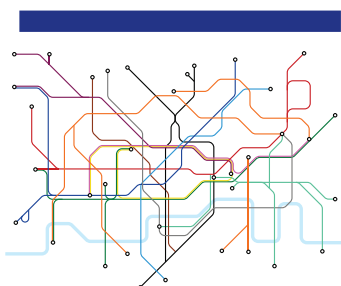
Then you can get the **W3** bus. This stops outside the entrance to Alexandra Palace.



## On the Underground

The closest Underground station to Alexandra Palace is **Wood Green**.

### Piccadilly line



You will need to use the **Piccadilly line** to get to Wood Green.



The Piccadilly line is coloured dark blue on the Underground map.

At Wood Green station, go to **bus stop A**.



Then you can get the **W3** bus to Alexandra Palace.



## By bus

The **W3** bus goes to Alexandra Palace.  
You can get the bus at:

- Finsbury Park station
- or
- Wood Green station



The bus will stop at the Ice Rink and Palm Court.
