



What to do if we ask you to leave the building in an emergency



It is important we keep everyone safe when they come to Alexandra Palace.



If we think there is any danger like a fire, we will ask everyone to leave.



Alarms

The first thing that will happen is an alarm will go off.



It is a very loud alarm. You can hear it everywhere in the building.



The alarm also has a flashing light. If you cannot hear the alarm you will see the light all over the building.



When you hear the alarm or see it flashing, you must leave the building.



Our staff will also tell people that they need to leave. They will tell you the best way to get out of the building.



If you have a carer or someone to support you, staff might ask them to help you leave the building.



Listen to what our staff tell you. It is their job to help you get out of the building safely.



Using the lifts and stairs

In an emergency, our lifts will not work.



If you are disabled or find it harder to move around, we have an **evacuation chair**.

This is a special chair to help you get down the stairs.



What to do if you have seats on the accessible platform

When you come to a concert here, you might have seats on our accessible platform.



Our staff might ask you to stay on the platform for a short time.



We might need to get people standing around the platform to move first.
